Information regarding the Stileapp subscription:

The 2017 stationery lists for Years 7 to 10 include an item called “Stileapp subscription”. This is an annual subscription to Stile which is an on-line platform built for e-learning. Stile is used widely in Australasia in both primary and secondary schools, in all subjects, from maths to English, PE and music. After an extensive trial in 2016 we have elected to use Stile across Years 7 to 10 Science classes. Stile has the potential to cover all curriculum areas and other faculties will be trialling it in 2017.

Stile permits learning through a social, digital and media rich medium, combining textbook, workbook and collaboration tools into one modern on-line space, accessible by students and teachers anywhere, at any time and on any device

Its ease of use and multimodal nature (ability to mix and match various media and question types) makes it easy for teachers to create engaging lessons and also give students real-time feedback to help move their learning forward.

As a parent you will be able to look at your student’s progress and teachers’ feedback to your child.

In 2020 students will be doing the majority of NCEA assessments online by computers so we want to adequately prepare our students for this. Using applications like Stile will help us to achieve this.

We are excited about this modern learning opportunity for our students. In order to make best use of time and resources, students will need to have signed up for a subscription by Friday 10th February (end of week 2 Term 1).
